**Dr. Kevin O'Neill's Bio:** Dr. Kevin O'Neill is an Associate Professor of Education and Technology at Simon Fraser University. He has taught at SFU for 12 years distance education and educational technology. His web site 'E-learning and distance education resources' has over 1,600 posts, over 1,000 'followers', and receives over 20,000 visits a month.

**Session Overview:** Dr. O'Neill will provide an overview of the Masters and PhD programs in Educational Technology and Learning Design at SFU, including descriptions of typical student cohorts, specific courses and assignments that students complete, and advice regarding the application process. An ETLD masters alumnus from VCC will be on hand, and there will be plenty of open time for Q&A. Applications for the Masters program open Nov 15, 2012 and are due Jan 31, 2013. Applications for the PhD program are due Jan 15th, 2013.

**Brief Description of the programs:** The Simon Fraser University's Master of Education and Master of Arts programs (offered at SFU Surrey) focus on research-based approaches to designing and using instructional technologies and evaluating their impact on learning. Masters graduates work in schools, universities, corporate training, Research & Development labs and informal learning environments.

The PhD program (offered at SFU Burnaby) is designed for careers in Research & Development and/or teaching at the post-secondary level. Based on an apprenticeship model of learning, students work closely with faculty members on cutting-edge research projects.
